Living Room

Wash furnace vents. Clean air conditioning vents, ceiling fans, and chandeliers. Clean doormats. Wash curtains and linens. Dust all surfaces, furniture, electronics, and lightbulbs. Dust books on the bookshelf. Clean floors and wipe baseboards. Clean blinds with microfiber a cloth. Wash windows and window tracks. Vacuum lampshades. Sweep out fireplace. Clean upholstery.

Bedroom

Wash all linens and pillows (for a better wash, use the deep soak setting if your washer has it). Dust all surfaces. Clean window treatments. Wash windows and mirrors. Steam carpets and throw rugs. Wipe the walls, ceiling, and ceiling fan. Clean mattress and rotate it (or flip it over if you can).

Kitchen

Wipe grease and crumbs away from appliances and stove top burners. Run lemons down garbage disposal to freshen it up. Organize pantry, dispose expired food. Scrub sink with bleach. Seal granite countertops. Wash garbage can. Clean the dish washer. Clean the range hood filter. Vacuum refrigerator coils. Clean oven glass. Sweep and mop floors.

Bathroom

Wipe walls and ceilings. Wash floor and linens. Clean shower head. Wash bathroom mirrors. Clean bathroom exhaust fan. Use carpet cleaner to clean tile grout. Scrub toilet, shower, and tub. Wash countertop, sink, and cabinets. Wipe door knobs and switches. Organize cabinet, dispose old products. Wash garbage can.

Closets and Other

Wash washer and dryer. Organize clothing and jewelry. Use an aromatherapy diffuser around the house to freshen it up. Wash outside windows. Clean out your car. Wash doors and dust door tops. Oil furniture applicable furniture. Wash exterior of your home with a power sprayer. Sweep concrete. Donate clothing that you have not worn within the past six months.
